

Travel options to Bassett Road Surgery

Bassett Road Surgery is on Bassett Road, just to the north east of Leighton Buzzard town centre. It is easy to get to on foot or by bicycle.

Walking

For many people living in Leighton Buzzard and Leighton Linlade, the surgery is just a short walk away. If the weather is fine you can use the Riverside Path. Walking uses three times as many calories as driving so it's the healthier option.

Cycling

If you can ride a bike, it's even quicker. The surgery has well located cycle parking. The map shows the Riverside Path cycling route, but if you want to cycle from further away see the excellent Central Bedfordshire Council Travel Choices Map, available at the surgery or online from Central Bedfordshire Council.

Car parking

Car parking is available including designated parking for Blue Badge holders close to the patients' entrance.

Bus

The nearest bus stops for most services in Leighton Buzzard are on the High Street. For the **150** service towards Heath and Reach you may prefer to use the bus stops on Church Street. See map for details of the walking routes from these bus stops. It is an 8 to 10 minute walk.

Town Centre Buses

D1 circular bus service - the Dash Direct. It runs every 30 minutes connecting Leighton Buzzard Rail Station, High Street, Billington Road, Sandhills and Grovebury Road. It is operated by Arriva.

32 / 33 hourly circular services in Leighton Buzzard. Operated by Arriva.

34 / 35 Leighton Buzzard Town

36A / 36C an hourly connection to High Street, Linlade and Billington Park. Operated by Grant Palmer.

70 running hourly to Milton Keynes, The Point, Linlade, Bletchley, Stoke



Hammond, Leighton Buzzard High Street, Leighton Buzzard Station, Tilsworth, Eggington, Hockcliffe, Dunstable, and Luton. Operated by Arriva.

150 runs hourly between Aylesbury, Bierton, Wingrave, Wing, Linlade, Leighton Buzzard, Heath and Reach, and Milton Keynes. Operated by Arriva.

49 runs every 2 hours between Leighton Buzzard, Woburn, Woburn Sands, Brogborough, and Wooton. Operated by Arriva.

10 Every 2 hours: Leighton Buzzard, Woburn, Woburn Sands and Milton Keynes. Operated by Grant Palmer.

165 approximately every 2 hours to Leighton Buzzard, Linlade, Wing, Cublington, Aston Abbots, Wingrave, Bierton, Aylesbury, Stoke Mandeville Hospital.

Other less regular and occasional services also serve the High Street, including the **71, 73** and **165**.

Door to door transport

Some people find it difficult or impossible to use existing bus services for a variety of reasons. For example, you may not be able to get on or off a bus because of a disability. Buzzer Buses Dial-a-Ride may be able to assist. They operate a door-to-door service for people who are unable to use ordinary buses. You need to become a member of Buzzer Buses Dial-a-Ride before you can use the service.
